

Birchmere – Advice for camping groups.

Here are a few points of advice that have been passed on to us
Please adhere to them if at all possible.

- Please advise Surrey Wildlife Trust if you wish to use the common for activities and read the Use of Common advice paperwork regarding their requirements.
- Follow the Countryside Code when in and outside our campsite
- Inform the Ranger of any night time common activities or of large fires or fireworks in the campsite
- There is a 10mph speed restriction on the access track.
- Do not obstruct access tracks or gates and only park vehicles where advised. The use of the top car park can be arranged if more than 15 vehicles are expected to park at the campsite.
- Chain saws are not permitted in the campsite or on the common.
- Wisley and Ockham Common is an area of SSSI please be aware of such things as ground nesting bird sites when walking off pathways.
- Cattle are grazing on the common land in summer – do not leave gates open.
- The Surrey Wildlife Trust Rangers are our colleagues and friends. Their advice must be adhered to.
- No vehicles are allowed on site unless by special agreement with the wardens.
- Birchmere has no refuse disposal arrangements. Take all rubbish home.
- Please leave the campsite and all facilities as you would expect to find them.
- Please follow all Birchmere Campsite rules.
- Have a great time at Birchmere!
